

### **Nampa Model Aviators Meeting – June 2012**

- Evening flying and a Bar B Q dinner, the June 2012 meeting was called to order at 7:05 P.M. by club president Jack Read. There were 23 members and 1 guest present.

**MOTION:** A motion made, seconded and unanimously voted to approve the May 2012 minutes as provided by E-mail.

### **President's Report:**

- Club President Jack Read thanked Bill Miller for cooking great burgers and also Cheryl Landram for providing a great pot of home made chili. Jack spoke briefly about the good turnout for the school districts science camp. We estimate that close to 100 middle school students were on hand for some training in basic aeronautics and also many got a chance to fly RC planes on the buddy box system.

### **Treasurers Report:**

- Treasurer Mike Jordan provided the members in attendance with a summary of the funds on hand in both accounts. All accounts are reported to be in great shape. We expect that with the addition of some potential new members our accounts will quickly grow.

### **Safety Officers Report:**

- Club Vice President and Safety Officer Larry Bresson reported that currently we have had no major safety issues or incidents. Members are reminded that they all have an individual responsibility to point out any potential safety problems. Members are also reminded that dogs must be kept on a leash or in the members vehicle at all times.
- Jack Read told the members that because the club membership has grown in the past year not to expect to fly alone during busy periods. The facility can easily accommodate 2 or 3 airplanes at the same time. When flying along side other pilots remember to notify the other pilots when taking off and landing also when the aircraft or pilot or both are on the runway.

### **Old Business:**

- The recent Saturday work party was a big success. Twenty members turned out and filled in the area adjacent to the runway with some dirt in order to remove the drop off next to the recently repaved runway.
- Jack Read mentioned that the mowing schedule will be held to one day a week, on Fridays. Mowing twice a week is not needed at this time and significant monies will be saved.
- The night flying on Thursdays and the Tuesday slow biplane pylon racing are both in full swing. Stop by and check out the activities.
- The fun fly was another big success. We had 19 registered pilots and many visitors. Thanks to Mike Nipp for organizing and directing the event and to Roc Cox and his student robotics club for once again, doing the cooking and food setup.
- After a short discussion the membership agreed that future events of this nature should involve more open flying and fewer competitions.

**New Business:** Public day is scheduled for July 14. Wayne Warner outlined the event and what preparations were ongoing. Volunteers are still needed to act as event helpers and buddy box pilots. Wayne may be contacting members to ask for help.
