

Nampa Model Aviators Meeting – September 11, 2014

Presidents Report:

- NMA President, Mike Nipp opened the meeting at 7:10 PM, there were 23 members present.
- Mike went over the results from the Warbirds Event. We had 20 pilots and over 60 airplanes that flew. It was a very successful event.

- Jack went over the procedures for the sound testing and remarked that the new system is working well. Two sound level meters are now available for use and will be kept inside the bulletin board. A test requires presence of an officer or board member. Jack also mentioned that he had met with the home owners association at the community to the North of the field and they seemed satisfied with our actions.

New Business:

- Mike Nipp said he was contacted by a Cub Scout pack in Boise and that they would like to come out as a group on a Saturday. Mike suggested that we might even let them fly on a buddy box. Anyone who would like to help is asked to contact Mike.
- The annual Snake River cross country fly-in is scheduled on October 4th at the Ontario club field. Everyone is welcome to participate.
- Mike Nipp introduced Bryan Wood who is our new Idaho associate VP for AMA. Bryan provided a very detailed report on AMA items that affect us here in the Treasure Valley. Bryan said that he wants more local flyers to apply to be an AMA Contest Director or an AMA Leader Member. Bryan also provided the latest update on the AMA-FAA issues involving the FAA's proposed rule making.
