Presidents Report:

We will be spraying weeds, filling some holes in the field with dirt, painting the shed and a general clean-up. **We need as many members to pitch in as possible. Please come out and help. This field belongs to all of us and we all should help maintain it.**
- We have been given a proposal from our lawn maintenance company, *Envirogreen*. They are quoting us the same price as last year and the consensus was to continue with this company. We will be doing our own fertilizer this year to save money. Mowing will be done on Tuesdays and Fridays from 12:00 PM to 3:00 PM.

- Andy Stynda donated several very nice WWII plastic models for the raffle he also brought in 3 gallons of fuel to give away. Thanks Andy
