Presidents Report:

- Following a burgers barbeque prepared by Mike Nipp and Mark Bell, NMA President, Mike Nipp opened the meeting at 7:25 PM, there were 23 members present.

The event is limited to EDF or prop driven jets. No turbine aircraft please as our facility is too small and is bordered by homes.
- We will offer T-shirts for both the jets event and the Warbirds Over Nampa in September. Mike Nipp will send out a notice to flyers to get orders. Thanks to Larry Bresson for the designs.
- Rob Epley said he still needs judges for the warbird scale judging. There will be a \$5.00 landing fee which will include lunch for pilots.
