

Nampa Model Aviators Meeting May 4, 2017

Presidents Report: Following a burgers and dogs barbeque hosted by Jack Read, club President Dennis Kirouac opened the May 2017 NMA Meeting at 7:00. There were 23 members present.

Treasurers Report:

- Mike Nipp provided the Treasurers Report. A rundown of both accounts was presented.

Safety Report:

- Safety Officer Bruce Chandler spoke about the AMA and FAA rules regarding First Person View (FPV) flying. FPV flyers must have a spotter when flying using FPV goggles and aircraft. The spotter would take control of the aircraft if it became hazardous to the pilot or spectators. FPV aircraft must stay within line-of-sight of both the pilot and spotter and must not exceed 400' in altitude. The 400' ceiling also applies to all aircraft flown at the NMA field.

Old Business:

- Annual Swap meet will be held at the flying field on Saturday May 20th from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. The runway will be closed during that time. There are no fees for sellers. Bring your own tables if you wish to display your aircraft for sale.
- Annual fun fly is coming up on the 10th of June. Bruce Chandler will be the event coordinator. We will need other members to act as event helpers. Bruce is planning the hold the bomb drop as the sole organized event. Other than that, the field will be open for flying to all who sign up. Pilots must have a current AMA membership to participate.
